# Few words about the Museum of Agriculture

- history of the museum in Szreniawa, dates back to the 1950s
- the Museum was officially established on 29 August 1964 on the site of a former nineteenth-century estate
- in the mid-1970s, the facility received the status of a National Museum
- museum collects, develops and makes accessible over 20.000 objects
- the exhibition area is over 5,000 square meters
- five thematic sections: beekeeping, wickerwork, meat industry, hunting, milling

# Few words about Milling Museum in Jaracz



- Milling Museum in Jaracz was created in the area of a former mill settlement
- first written mention of a mill in Jaracz dates back to 1445
- in the early 1980s, the area became the property of the National Museum of Agriculture in Szreniawa
- the museum was officially opened in may 1989
- facilities available: water mill, wind mill, turbine mill, mill stable, millers house



# Few words about Milling Museum in Jaracz

- over 350 museum objects
- the museum covers almost 4 hectares



# Where is Szreniawa?

- Museum of Agriculture is located 14 km south from the Poznan Ławica airport

- Milling Museum in Jaracz is located 40 km north from Poznan on the route no. 11 Poznan–Pila, at the eastern end of the Notec Forest.

- Distance between both museums is 60 km

- located right next to the protected areas of the Greater Poland National Park



# How to get?

-> by plane

Poznan-Ławica Airport is located 7 kilometers from the city center, on the route leading directly to the most important points in the city and to Berlin and Warsaw.

All airports in Poland are well connected to largest European cities

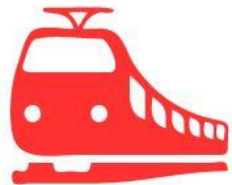


# How to get?

->by car&train



The roads in Poland are quite good, and Poznan is in a great location near the A2 motorway, which runs through the central areas of Poland. It is a part of the international road E30.



Poznan has excellent railway connections with all major cities in the country, as well as with some of the most important cities in Europe. All trains arriving in Poznan stops at the Main Train Station



# POZNAN

- Poznan is a centre of trade, sport, education, technology and tourism.
- Great hotel base, various restaurants, countless museums and good communication
- Distance between the city center and the Museum of Agriculture is about 15 km by car or train



# National Museum of Agriculture

The museum in Szreniawa offers TIMS symposium participants:

- a parking base for 200 spots
- conference rooms for 100 people
- additionally smaller conference rooms in the palace
- a building called BARN for 150 people where we plan to organize a ceremonial banquet at the end of the symposium
- right next to the main entrance of the museum there is a railway stop with a direct connection to the Poznan Main Train Station
- small restaurant with traditional food

# Hotel base – DELICJUSZ HOTEL



- hotel Delicjusz - less than five minutes away from the Museum of Agriculture
- in the hotel will be a base for accommodation and a place of relaxation for all symposium participants

## Hotel offers:

- several thousand meters of exhibition area inside the building
- garden
- parking for over 200 parking spots
- hotel and catering facilities all at the same place

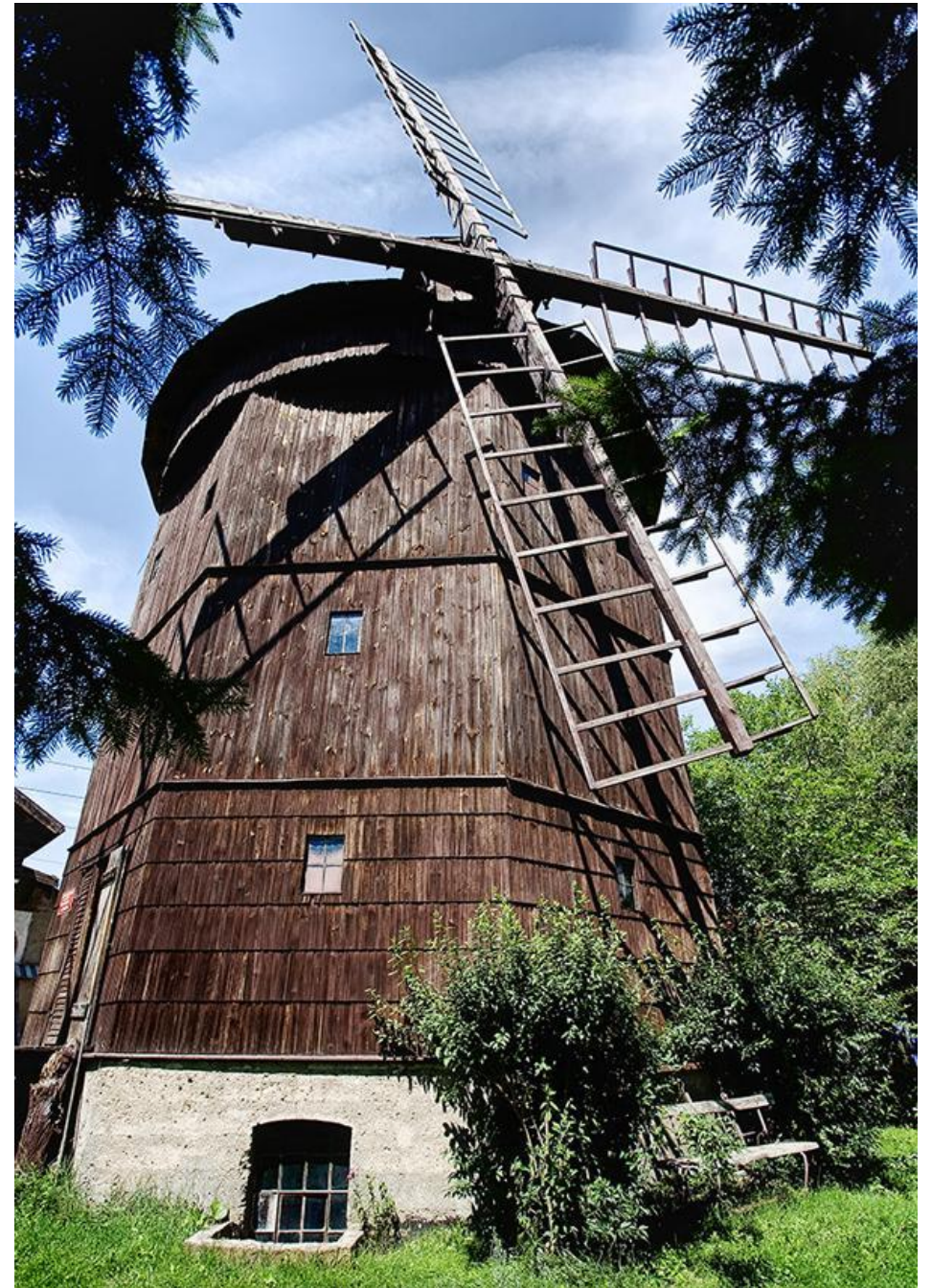

- Powrd by Francise turbine



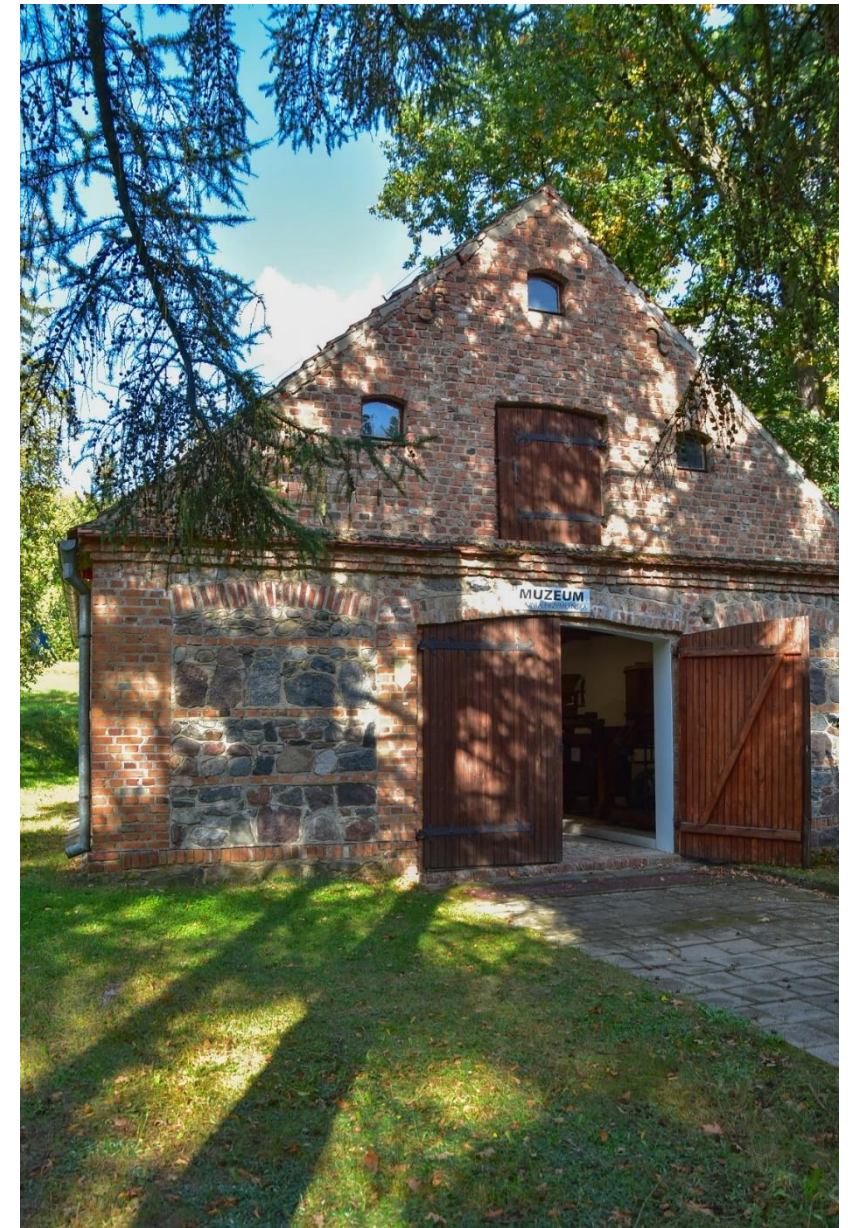
